

**RTW Town Forum Grot Spot Update – 22 June 2006**

Ex Plant & Tools site adjacent to petrol station Eridge Road (site of unsuccessful application for a Aldi Store)	Aldi has undertaken further clear ups and for a second time painted over the graffiti. The cars have been removed from the site.
Footway from Mount Pleasant Road to the station	Graffiti removed from side of shoe repair shop. Station Manager approached by Street Scene Enforcement Officer to clear the area of land above the entrance to the tunnel. Works to be undertaken but special arrangements required for safe access
30 Warwick Park	The site was resecured week ending 2 June No response has been received from the owner following the threat of enforcement action. To be followed up Sealed letter from a person interested in the property forwarded to the owner by the Council (This was the person that e-mailed George Lawson via the Friends of the Commons)
18 Victoria Road	Further legal action pending
Greyhound Pub	The owner, Punch Taverns approached to clear site of graffiti. Request made for details of their plans for the site. No reply received to date, awaiting a call back.
16 Monson Colonnade	Initial approach to the owner to advise owner of the poor condition of the property and to offer assistance.
Victorian sewer vent pipes (25) * - various locations within town	Southern Water has promised to look into funding, to restore these. Their liaison office has been put in contact with Brain Hayward (TWBC).
Cinema Site	Whole site still to be vacated. Development Control have written to applicant's agent requesting further details regarding demolition method statement, 9 June.

Borough Council's street furniture: TWBC is also just about to start a programme of repainting
